

**466 BAGGETT, CHARLES**

**Bookbinder**

**Fredericksburg**

Bookbinder in Fredericksburg in 1820.

Baggett is known to have been a part of the Virginia print trade solely from an advertising notice that he placed in the *Virginia Herald* in December 1820, reporting that he had just commenced business in the town. His origin and fate, however, remain unknown, though it seems likely that Baggett came from Alexandria, given the numerous individuals with his surname residing there; if so, this tradesman would have been a part of the continuing migration of bookbinders to Fredericksburg from that Potomac River port after 1800; still those possibilities remain pure speculation without further evidence.
