**Bookbinder**

**Richmond**

Bookbinder in Richmond (1815-19).

Patrick Roche is known to have been a part of Virginia's print trade as a result of his being recorded in Richmond tax lists from 1815 to 1819 as a bookbinder living in that city. (His surname was also sometimes spelled Roache in those city records.) Yet those enumerations do not report who employed him in any of those five years, nor is there any evidence of his presence in Richmond in contemporaneous papers. So, lacking any additional information on Roche from this era, nothing can be said of his origin, his family, or his fate.
