The only evidence that Thomas Smith was a part of the Virginia print trade is found in the city tax census for Richmond in 1793. That enumeration does not specify his employer, so indicating that he was a transient journeyman in the capital. Unfortunately, his exceedingly common name bars any further identification without additional information.
