At a General Assembly, begun and held at the college in the city of Williamsburg, on Thursday the twenty seventh day of February, in the twenty fifth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord, George II. by the grace of God, of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, &c. and in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and fifty two. And from thence continued, by several prorogations, to Thursday the twenty second day of August, in the twenty eighth year of His Majesty's reign, and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty four, and then held at the capitol in the city of Williamsburg; being the fourth session of this Assembly.

Notes: Brief session (August 22 to September 5) prorogued by Dinwiddie for its inaction in the wake of George Washington's defeat at Fort Necessity on July 3rd.

Hunter was absent from Williamsburg from June 1754 to April 1755; his office's production was handled by John Stretch during his absence.
