Title: Anno regni Georgii II, Regis Magnae Britanniae, Franciae, & Hiberniae, vicesimo nono. : At a General Assembly, begun and held at the college, in the city of Williamsburg, on Thursday the 27th day of February in the 25th year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George II. by the grace of God, of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, &c. and in the year of our Lord 1752. And from thence continued by several prorogations, to Monday the 27th day of October, in the 29th year of His Majesty's reign, and in the year of our Lord 1755, and then held at the capitol, in the city of Williamsburg: being the eighth session of this Assembly.

Notes: Third session of the year, called to address disruptions on the frontier caused by Braddock's defeat at Fort Duquesne on July 13th, and desertions from the militia forces that were raised earlier in the year; Assembly met from October 22 to November 8, 1755.
