At a General Assembly, begun and held at the Capitol, in Williamsburg, on Thursday the fourteenth day of September, in the thirty-second year of the reign of Our Sovereign Lord George II. by the grace of God, of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland, king, defender of the faith &c. and in the year of Our Lord, 1758; and from thence continued by prorogation to Thursday the 9th of September [i.e. November], in the year of Our Lord 1758; and then held at the Capitol, in Williamsburg; being the second session of this Assembly.
