At a General Assembly, begun and held at the capitol, in Williamsburg, on Thursday the sixth of November, in the seventh year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord George III. by the grace of God, of Great-Britain, France, and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, &c. and in the year of our Lord 1766; and then held at the capitol in Williamsburg; being the first session of this Assembly.

Notes: First session (two meetings: November 6 to December 16, 1766 and March 12 to April 11, 1767) of the Assembly of 1766-1769. The acts of both meetings are in this one volume.

Surviving copies lack title page, having been bound with other sets of session laws; the title recorded above is caption title from first page of text. Evans incorrectly assigned this imprint to Alexander Purdie & John Dixon; William Rind was elected as public printer on November 7, 1766, the second day of the first meeting, in the place of Purdie & Dixon, who had acted as in that role after the death of Joseph Royle in January 1766; they printed only the Address of the Governor (1766.006) and the Council's reply (1766.007) for this session before they were supplanted by Rind.
