Notes: First and only session (June 1 to June 24, 1775) of the Assembly of 1774-1776.

Imprint presents the collected written exchanges between Lord Dunmore and the House of Burgesses over the course of the session; no bills were passed as Dunmore would not return to Williamsburg out of fear for his personal safety, while the House would not meet with the fugitive governor elsewhere to conduct the Assembly's business.
