Title: Journal of the house of delegates of Virginia. General assembly begun and held at the town of Richmond in the county of Henrico, on Monday the seventh day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty-one, in the buildings provided by the public directors, pursuant to the act for the removal of the seat of government.

Place Issued: Charlottesville

Issuing Press: Dunlap & Hayes

Notes: Assembly session began in Richmond on May 7th and was immediately adjourned until May 24th at Charlottesville as a result of approaching British military operations; adjourned again on June 4th until June 7th at Staunton, where it continued until June 23, 1781.

John Dunlap and James Hayes were appointed as Virginia's public printers in November 1780, but several war-time incidents kept them from printing in Richmond until December 1781; they conducted some public business in Charlottesville during the government's western exile in the summer of 1781; this is one of those imprints.
