Notes: Petitioning the forthcoming General Assembly (October 1793) to enact a law "enlarging the capital stock of the Bank of Alexandria, to the sum of three hundred thousand dollars" with manuscript signatures of city's principal merchants and business agents.

Sheet lacks printer credit; at date mentioned in text, the only press operating in Alexandria was that of Hanson & Bond; Hanson was regularly a part of efforts to expanding banking in Alexandria, so this imprint undoubtedly issued from his press.
