Notes: Additional sheet for the December 22, 1797, edition of the *Argus*, then published twice-weekly (Tuesday/Friday) by Samuel Pleasants; this extra carried an account of the British victory in the Battle of Camperdown (*Zeeslag bij Kamperduin*) of October 11, 1797 – the largest and most decisive naval action fought by the British navy to that date, ending Dutch naval support for the French forces then engaged against Great Britain and her allies.
