Notes: No copy known; existence recorded by several authorities, but the Early American Imprints Series could not locate a copy for filming. John Dixon Jr., himself a Mason, was printer to the Grand Lodge from April 1791 until his death in May 1805, so the attribution here.

Walgren reports a ghost entry for this item (Bristol B9939; Shipton & Mooney 48124) that could not be found where cited; likely a "bound with" variant linked to Proceedings of November 1797 (1798.010), which was issued at about the same time.
