Notes: Yancey served in Assemblies of December 1799 and December 1800, before he was elected sheriff of Louisa County; he later served as the Lieutenant colonel of the 40th Regiment of Virginia Militia.

No copy known extant; Swem recorded this title from the Library of Congress catalogue, but the letter is no longer listed there; letter is dated the day before the Assembly adjourned, indicating a Richmond origin, but its printer remains unknown.
