Notes: Text details conditions for subscribing for a set of "two octavo volumes." and concludes with notation that "Subscription papers will be left with the clerks of the different county and corporation courts throughout the state. Winchester, June 17, 1801."

Proposed work never issued, probably as a result of a competing collection of Virginia laws proposed by Richmond printers Samuel Pleasants and Henry Pace that fall, a project which had a broader appeal and the patronage of the Assembly itself (see 1801.043).

Sheet lacks colophon; Caldwell was one of Winchester's leading Republican figures, as well as father of printers James and Joseph F. Caldwell; so it is most likely that this subscription form issued from the Republican press of George Trisler, where those sons began their training.
