Notes: None of the standard bibliographic authorities record an extant second volume, nor do any modern digital catalogues; original edition (1797) was a three-volume imprint, suggesting that this Alexandria edition was an extract that was never completed with a second volume.

The brothers Robert & John Gray conducted a successful bookstore in Alexandria from 1800 to 1808, when John retired from the business; Robert continued alone until 1814.
