Notes: A separate printing of Chap. CXVIII of the Acts of the December 1803 Assembly, enacted into law on January 30, 1804. While such items were usually printed by the public printer, this Assembly was one marked by the increasing substitution of Pleasants for Meriwether Jones in that office; from summer 1803 until March 1804, Jones was titular printer but regularly subcontracted work to Pleasants, as seen here.
