Notes: Sheet contains a poem dated in print: Richmond, June 10th, 1804; note at foot of the sheet reports: "We are extremely happy to find that Justice is Religious. She appears fond of borrowing from Lorenzo Dow." Only known copy, held by the Virginia Historical Society, is mutilated with loss of text and signed: "Aldiberontifoscophonio."

Broadside lacks colophon; as numerous job presses operated in Richmond at this time, no clear identification of this title's source can be made.
