Notes: Dow was an itinerant Methodist preacher from Connecticut who made his first appearances in Virginia in 1804; this imprint was the first Virginia variant of his first publication, *The Chain of Lorenzo*, originally published in Augusta, Georgia, in 1803, issued now under its better known title of *Lorenzo's Thoughts*; Dow would issue more than thirty separate editions of this work over the next three decades, varying length and content over time; a second Virginia variant, comprising the second half of this title, was issued in Richmond later this same year (1804.023) to facilitate fundraising for construction of a meeting house on the Dan River in south-central Virginia.
