Wilson Lee (1764-1804) was the presiding elder of the Methodists' Baltimore Conference; the three men mentioned were all Methodist circuit ministers then serving in the mid-Atlantic region, indicating that George's sermon was being published as a memorial to their fallen colleague and was intended for a wide distribution along the circuits they rode.
