Notes: Petitioners asked that an act of the December 1804 Assembly that prohibited the circulation of notes issued by private banks be repealed; the request was rejected on January 9, 1806.

Sheet lacks colophon; multiple copies of this petition were considered by the Committee for Courts of Justice from Augusta, Fairfax, Fauquier, Loudoun, Prince William, and Shenandoah Counties; that breadth indicates possible publication in Staunton, Fredericksburg, Alexandria, or Leesburg, precluding attribution to any specific place or press without more evidence.
