Resolved unanimously, that all communication with the British ships of war, now within our waters and on our coasts, and with their agent or agents among us, be discontinued ...

Notes: Detailed report of the fourteen resolutions adopted at a public meeting called to respond to the attack on *USS Chesapeake* by *HMS Leopard* on the evening on June 22nd; signed in print by Gen. Thomas Mathews as chair and Samuel Moseley as secretary.

Sheet lacks colophon; typography and page size are identical to the *Extra of Norfolk Gazette & Publick Ledger* (1807.059) issued the day before, indicating a common origin; in June 1807, that newspaper was conducted by editor William Davis for proprietor John Cowper, hence the attribution here.
