In previous years, the firm had its annual almanac printed in Richmond by Seaton Grantland; his removal to Georgia evidently led to their employing another non-Petersburg printer to produce this edition for them, as evinced by the unfamiliarity seen with the misspelled name of the title page; however, no other evidence has been found to determine where this item was printed and by whom.
