Notes: Imprint lacks colophon; newspaper advertising indicates the "Mechanico Microcosmico" was exhibited in Richmond in January 1811, so establishing this title as an early 1811 imprint; however, the unnamed exhibitor published two other such notices employing both Thomas P. Manson (1811.028) and John Warrock (1811.029), so leaving it an open question as to which of those two printers produced this broadside.
