Notes: Letter circulates names of electors pledged to James Monroe for President and to Daniel D. Tompkins for Vice President in the 1816 election; signers represent the membership of the so-called Richmond Junto at this time.

Sheet lacks colophon; as Ritchie was both a member of the committee and a signers of this letter, this title certainly issued from his press office, so the attribution here.
