The reported first edition has also been attributed to the Caldwell press (1817.076), even as it carries the simple imprint "Printed for the author, 1817" as a result of this later version; Balcom noted here that he retitled this work as *Confession of the Prince of Darkness* after hearing complaints about his use of the word "devil" in that for the first edition: *The Devil on Politics; or, The History of Political Religion*.
