As this item was printed in Woodstock, this Index reports this as a Woodstock title and not an Alexandria one; Bogan was a job printer in Alexandria before being brought to Shenandoah County by Williams, the county clerk, in the winter of 1817-18; this item was apparently a pending commitment to Stewart that Bogan did not complete until after his relocation.
