Notes: Snider began publishing his *Lexington News-Letter* in February 1819; his journal experienced frequent interruptions for want of paper during its run, as seen here, though it is unknown whether such embarrassments were from insufficiency at the mill or Snider's financial woes; the *Lexington News-Letter* died with its founder in June 1820.
