Notes: Only known copy, held by the Library of Congress, lacks colophon; Thomas Ritchie, the public printer, was ordered on February 19, 1821, to print 250 copies of this amended bill for use of the Assembly; while Ritchie held an interest in the press office of Daniel Trueheart & Samuel Cary at this time, he also regularly subcontracted public work to that of Samuel Shepherd & William Pollard; absence of evidence for which press he assigned this item, so making him the only person identified with this title.
