Publication apparently suspended to settle accounts of partnership then being dissolved.

**Variant 02: Republican Compiler**

Publication Data: About July 24, 1818 to July 28, 1820 or after. Weekly

Proprietors: Gideon Butler

IVP Associates: Gideon Butler (067)

Notes: Butler announced change in title for Western Virginian on February 22, 1817, effective April 1st; only surviving run of issues of this title (January to July 1820) indicates that the change was accompanied by a fifteen-month suspension; first number of the new title issued July 24, 1818; last known was issued July 28, 1820, with Butler advertising sale of his office within days, so indicating a probable termination on that date.
