Notes: Published in Georgetown, DC. Fierer opened a job-press there with Christian Kramer in 1788, but publication of this weekly in February 1789 caused dissolution of printing firm by that April. With issue of November 25, 1789, Fierer took on Thomas U. Fosdick as his new partner. Office was removed to Dumfries sometime after issue of July 6, 1791 (last known) to avoid its seizure under a collection order in Maryland.

Publication Data: September 29, 1791 to December 19, 1793 Weekly

Proprietors: Fierer & Fosdick

IVP Associates: Charles Fierer (163), Thomas Updike Fosdick (164)

Notes: Fierer & Fosdick brought their press office to Dumfries from Georgetown shortly before this paper issued in order to avoid its seizure under a collection order in Maryland. Their firm was dissolved sometime between the issues of November 24, 1791 and June 14, 1792, leaving Fierer sole proprietor until closing paper with issue of December 19, 1793.
