Variante 02: Republican Journal and Dumfries Weekly Advertiser

Publication Data: By October 2, 1795 to about November 1795 Weekly

Proprietors: James Kempe & Co.

IVP Associates: James Kempe (247). Willoughby Tebbs (526);

Notes: Between August 14 and October 2, 1795, the word "Weekly" was added to the title of this journal; the paper continued under this title until its demise in November 1796.

Variante 03: Republican Journal and Dumfries Weekly Advertiser

Publication Data: By February 11, 1796 to about April 1796 Weekly

Proprietors: James Kempe & Thomas Thornton

IVP Associates: James Kempe (247). Thomas Thornton (414)

Notes: Sometime between October 2, 1795 and February 11, 1796, Willoughby Tebbs conveyed his interest in this paper to Dr. Thomas Thornton, creating the firm of Kempe & Thornton.

Variante 04: Republican Journal and Dumfries Weekly Advertiser

Publication Data: By April 7, 1796 to November 3, 1796 Weekly

Proprietors: Thomas Thornton

IVP Associates: Thomas Thornton (414)

Notes: Between February 11 and April 7, 1796, Kempe retired from firm of Kempe & Thornton; he likely printed paper for Thornton until its demise with the November 3, 1796 issue.
