Notes: Only issue known extant is that for December 5, 1800 (vol. 1, no. 40), establishing start date here. Oldest extant number of ensuing title (May 8, 1801 – vol. 2, no. 61) indicates a continuous run between the two titles, except for a one issue/week gap, suggesting paper had a short-term supply-shortage suspension in the winter of 1800-1801.

Variant 02: The Fincastle Weekly Advertiser

Publication Data: By May 8, 1801 to July 10, 1801 Weekly

Proprietors: John & David Amen

IVP Associates: David Ammen (008), John Ammen (009)

Notes: Sometime between December 5, 1800 and May 8, 1801. Ammen shortened the title of his weekly and added his brother John as a partner. The May 8th issue carried a notice asking payment of arrearages by July 10, 1801; the issue of that date (vol. 2, no. 70) is last known extant, indicating the paper did cease publication with that issue as promised in May.
