Notes: Shift from weekly to semiweekly frequency also saw substitution of "or" for "and" in title.

Variant 03: The Virginia Telegraphe; or Rockbridge Courier

Publication Data: February 28, 1804 to October 8, 1804 2/week

Proprietors: Walkup & Lyford

Notes: With issue of February 28, 1804, Walkup took on Ustick as partner; dissolution of firm of Walkup & Lyford with issue of October 8, 1804 put paper into suspension to August 1806.

Variant 04: Virginia Telegraphe

Publication Data: August 23, 1806 to after February 3, 1808 Weekly

Proprietors: Samuel Walkup & Co.

Notes: Restarted with new volume (vol. 3, no. 1) on August 23, 1806; published weekly, though with double date conforming to its former semiweekly pace; Last issue known extant is for February 3, 1808, though Isaiah Thomas included it in his 1810 list of newspapers then in print in the United States, suggesting its cessation sometime that year.
