Publication Data: June 2 1797 to May 26 1798 Weekly

Proprietors: John Davis & Co.

IVP Associates: John Davis (124); John Carter (083)

Notes: Start date established by issue of August 21, 1797 (vol. 1, no. 12); only 6 numbers extant, with latest issue being that for May 19, 1798 (vol. 1, no 51); local histories report sale at end of first volume, so date noted here.

**Variant 02: Lynchburg Weekly Gazette**

Publication Data: June 2, 1798 to after May 2, 1801 Weekly

Proprietors: John Carter & Co.

IVP Associates: John Carter (083)

Notes: Davis sold paper to Carter in May 1798 and retired from the trade; earliest known issue is for Oct. 13, 1798 (vol. 1, no. 20) of 14 numbers extant; latest issue is for May 2, 1801 (vol. 3, no. 48), so indefinite end date here.

**Variant 03: Lynchburg Gazette**

Publication Data: By October 1802 to before February 1804 Weekly

Proprietors: John Carter & Co.

IVP Associates: John Carter (083) John Weaver (433)

Notes: Only known issue for December 29, 1802, indicates ownership of John Carter & Co.; article reprinted in [Baltimore] *Republican, or Anti-Democrat* on October 19, 1802, indicates that Weaver was partner to Carter at this time.

**Variant 04: Lynchburg Gazette**

Publication Data: By February 22, 1804 to February 7, 1805 Weekly

Proprietors: John Weaver

IVP Associates: John Weaver (433)

Notes: No issues known extant; Weaver's proprietorship established by external references only; he died on February 7, 1805, so ending his association with the *Gazette*.

**Variant 05: Lynchburg Gazette**

Publication Data: February 8, 1805 to after September 11, 1805 Weekly

Proprietors: M.W. Weaver & Bros.

IVP Associates: Matthew W. Weaver (543)

Notes: Only issue known is for September 11, 1805 (vol. 8 no. 11, whole no. 379); proprietors were brothers of John Weaver; they sold office & press to James Graham in August 1805, who issued the first number of succeeding the *Lynchburg Star* on October 31 1805; so end date of Gazette falls between September 11th and October 31st.
