Notes: Only known issue for June 23, 1804 (no. 25) now lost; start date calculated from that issue by Brigham and Norona & Shetler alike; could have begun earlier as Campbell & Britton appear to have moved to Morgantown the preceding fall.

Variant 02: The Monongalia Gazette

Publication Data: From January 1806 to about March 1810 Weekly

Proprietors: Joseph Campbell

IVP Associates: Joseph Campbell (078)

Notes: Only two issues from fall of 1809 known (September 8 & October 6); Britton removed to Clarksburg shortly after his marriage in November 1805, suggesting his arrangement with Campbell ended at close of second volume in January 1806, so start date reported here. Title was likely shortened at that time. Transfer to Laidley reported as spring 1810 in local histories, so end date reported here.

Variant 02: The Monongalia Gazette

Publication Data: About March 1810 to after August 10, 1810 Weekly

Proprietors: John Osborne Laidley

IVP Associates: John Osborne Laidley (258)

Notes: Only issue known is for August 10, 1810; according to local histories, Laidley bought paper in spring 1810, so start date reported here; Laidley removed to Parkersburg in fall 1810, so paper likely closed at about time of surviving issue, so end date reported here.
