Notes: New York publisher McLean established this weekly in June 1786 a southern end of a two paper combine; continued alone in business until brother arrived in June 1788 to increase pace of production in New York, while a partner in both papers.

Variant 02: The Norfolk and Portsmouth Journal

Publication Data: June 18, 1788 to May 6, 1789 Weekly

Proprietors: John & Archibald McLean

IVP Associates: John Mclean (297), Archibald Mclean (296)

Notes: In June 1788, McLean brought his younger brother to New York to increase the frequency of his paper there, so making him a partner in both the Norfolk and New York papers; John Mclean died unexpectedly in May 1789, bringing publication of *Journal* to an end; Archibald sold office to William Prentis and Daniel Baxter, who used it to begin publishing a succeeding paper in August 1789.
