Publication Data: May 25, 1799 to August 2, 1800 2/week (Wed, Sat)

Proprietors: William A. Rind

Notes: First issued on May 25, 1799 as partisan counterpoint to the *Examiner* of Meriwether Jones, the Republican public-printer; continued uninterrupted until August 2, 1800, when Rind and Stewart relocated paper to Georgetown, DC; reappeared there on September 25, 1800 as the *Washington Federalist*.

**Variant XX: Washington Federalist**

Publication Data: September 25, 1800 to June 20, 1809 Varied

Proprietors: Rind & Stewart

IVP Associates: William A. Rind (359), John Stewart (401), James Bagnall (467), Charles Prentiss (341)

Notes: Relocated from Richmond, first issue in Georgetown, DC, appeared September 25, 1800 with new title; Stewart withdrew from firm in May 1801, with editor Prentiss becoming a partner in September 1801; he withdrew from concern in March 1802, leaving Rind sole proprietor; bankruptcy forced sale of his office in July 1804, though he continued paper from job-presses until August 1808; the paper then acquired by Jonathan S. Findlay, who conducted it until June 20, 1809, when paper finally closed; its office and subscriber list then passed to Edgar Patterson, who issued new *Independent American* on July 1, 1809.
