Publication Data: January 1, 1808 to March 22, 1808 2/week (Tues, Fri)

Proprietors: Printed for Gerard Banks by Seaton Grantland

IVP Associates: Gerard Banks (019), Seaton Grantland (186)

Notes: Campaign newspaper published in support of presidential candidacy of James Monroe as successor to Thomas Jefferson; initially printed for Banks by Grantland on what appears to be a three-month contract, which corresponds to dates reported here.

**Variant 02: The Virginian**

Publication Data: March 25, 1808 to June 31, 1808 2/week (Tues, Fri)

Proprietors: Printed for Gerard Banks by T. P. Manson

IVP Associates: Gerard Banks (019), Thomas Pescud Manson (278)

Notes: Manson replaced Grantland as printer for Banks with issue of March 25, 1808; paper does not report a printer after issue of June 31, 1808, indicating that a three-month contract with Manson for printing paper expired on that date, and that Banks did not employ a new printer on same contractual terms as he had Manson and Grantland previously.

**Variant 03: The Virginian**

Publication Data: July 4, 1808 to November 8, 1808 2/week (Tues, Fri)

Proprietors: Gerard Banks

IVP Associates: Gerard Banks (019)

Notes: Issues from July 4, 1808 on all lack production credit, suggesting Banks did not contract a printer for a fixed-term after that with Manson expired as Monroe's chances faded away that fall; last issue known (vol. 1: no. 81) is that for election day (November 8, 1808); as this journal was a campaign paper, end of campaign evidently ended publication need.
