Notes: Older reference sources mistranscribe surname of John Hass as Haff, reading their use of an archaic long "s" [ſ] as an "f." Earliest issue known extant is that for May 13, 1801 (v. 2, no. 93); if numbering of that issue is continuous, its calculated start date is July 31, 1799, so date reported here; latest issue known with this proprietary name is that for March 31, 1803; by issue of May 29, 1803, partnership of Trisler & Hass had been dissolved, with Trisler becoming paper's sole proprietor.

Variant 02: Triumph of Liberty

Publication Data: By May 29, 1803 to after November 29, 1803 Weekly

Proprietors: George Trisler

IVP Associates: George Trisler (419)

Notes: Sometime between issues of March 31 and May 29, 1803, Trisler became sole proprietor of this title; last number known is issue for November 29, 1803; succeeding title published by Trisler's journeymen (*Independent Register*) commenced about March 20, 1804; they acquired Trisler's press sometime after last known issue of this title and before the first of their paper, suggesting Trisler ceased publication on change of years, either on December 26, 1803, or January 2, 1804; later date would have completed half of fifth volume/year.
