Notes: Dunlap & Hayes, the public printers, were ordered to print copies of the act on the day it was enacted. Act provided for a convention in the district to draft a state constitution that would be submitted to the Confederation Congress; it also included instructions to the Virginia delegation in Congress to press for enactment of this law's provisions at the national level.
