Notes: This title is typographically identical to the *Virginia Almanack for the year of our Lord 1806* (1805.037), also issued by Cottom & Stewart for John Gray, and their own *Town and Country Almanack for 1806* (1805.038), with the exception of the word "Jefferson" used on the title page in place of "Virginia" or "Town and Country." Gray was evidently attempting to market this edition to Republican sympathizers in the capital-district region.
