Notes: Sheet lacks colophon; proximity of Belle Air to Fredericksburg means this was most likely issued there; on the date reported, the press of Green & Cady was the only one in operation in Fredericksburg; hence the attribution here; firm of Green & Cady was formed in August 1811 when bookseller Cady joined printer Green in Virginia; both were Connecticut natives.
