Benjamin Abbott," by one John Ffirth; third part [287-292] is "A short account of Benjamin Abbott by Hugh Smith, in a letter to Ezekiel Cooper. Philadelphia, October 7th, 1801." Dilworth was a leader of the Methodist evangelical movement in Rockingham County; this is the only imprint he ever published.

Shoemaker inadvertently recorded item twice, so the two entry numbers reported here.
